Volunteers at HME

- Charging rules for cafeteria: students are allowed 3 charges (or \$9.00). After this the student will receive a cheese sandwich and milk until lunch is paid. They will receive toast and milk at breakfast.
- Parents may pay at www.myschoolaccount.com. There is a \$2.00 transaction fee.
