Recommended Treatment Plan for Head Lice Checklist

- _____1. I have read the information provided by the school nurse.
- _____2. Purchased an FDA approved pediculicide product.
- _____3. Removed clothing of person being treated.
- _____4. Followed directions on box, applying treatment to dry hair.
- _____5. Used a clean towel and put on clean, different clothing after treatment.
- _____6. Treated all persons needing treatment in household on the same day.
- _____7. Treated each person individually using entire contents of 2 oz. container.
- _____8. Laundered all washable clothing and bed linens in hot water.
- _____9. Dry cleaned all non-washables or wrapped them in a sealed plastic bag (such as clothing, stuffed animals, and pillows) to remain sealed for two weeks.
- _____10. Vacuumed carpeting and upholstery in home and car. Removed bag from vacuum and discarded.
- _____11. Soaked brushes and combs in a pediculicide or hot water for one hour.
- _____12. Discussed preventing the spread of lice by not sharing combs, brushes, hats, scarves, coats, pillows, and towels with others.
- _____13. Agree to comb child's hair nightly with a metal pick comb for one week and remove any remaining nits by hand.
- _____14. Agree to retreat in 7 days with an FDA approved pediculicide product.
- _____15. I have complied with the procedures above. I am aware of the readmission policy and will return the required items to school with my child.
