



MISD Health Services Designation of Unlicensed Assistive Personnel

Re: Designation of Qualified Medical Personnel to Train and Qualify Unlicensed Assistive Personnel for administration of medication under emergency circumstances

Dear Melissa Independent School District Nurse or Medical Professional:

To address the concerns of certain students who unexpectedly may need prompt administration of medication for a variety of conditions, including but not limited to anaphylaxis, asthma, diabetes and seizures, it has become necessary to ensure that a sufficient number of persons employed by the District or volunteering with the District may act should emergency conditions arise. Accordingly, in my capacity as Superintendent of Melissa Independent School District ("MISD") and to the extent necessary to protect the health and welfare of students of MISD, I hereby appoint the Nurse or other licensed medical professional assigned to each campus as my designee for purposes of appointing, training, and qualifying unlicensed assistive personnel ("UAP") at the campus(es) to which the nurse/medical professional is assigned. UAPs will be designated personnel with authority to administer medication should the need arise to student who have received appropriate designations of the potential need for rescue drugs from their physician(s) and authorization from their parents/guardians for administration by UAPs.
